AdBlue Spill Kits



Description of the good practice

A large amount of AdBlue is being used across all BAM Nuttall sites. It was identified that AdBlue is not absorbed by standard spill kits and requires a different pad to be absorbed properly if spilled. BAM ordered several of spill kits and kept them by the compressors, plant and also in the COSHH store by the AdBlue storage, in case of a spill.

What are the benefits?

- No more expensive than a standard spill kit.
- Not necessarily well known that a different spill kit is required for AdBlue spills, so glad this was brought to our attention.
