Description of the good practice

Following the increase of hand injuries in the construction industry, Volkerfitzpatrick have implemented a new Cut 5 index E class glove, from Stalsen. The glove is touch screen compatible, ideal for working in dry and slightly oily conditions, has an ultra-light weight liner and good dexterity. As a result, the number of Close Calls raised for not wearing gloves has reduced. The team are also trialling a warning sign on the gloves. The gloves come complete with plastic free packaging and the glove will be thermal for winter from the end of this year.

What are the benefits?

- Operatives willing to wear the gloves.
- Engineers can use survey instruments
- Supervisors and safety critical staff can use phones and tablets.
- Complete with plastic-free packaging
- Cost savings the Stalsen glove cost half the price than the previous glove

Are there any drawbacks?
