Description of the good practice

Due to the potential risks associated with incorrect storage and classification of waste and the removal of small quantities of hazardous waste on the framework, Hazibags are a solution to better manage the risk.

These bags remove the risk of mixing waste streams e.g. paint flakes removed from the bridge with general construction waste. The Hazibags are clearly distinguishable and are a better alternative to using standard skips.

What are the benefits?

- Flexible and versatile.
- UN certified product- can be collected by any waste carrier.
- Suitable for a wide range of hazardous wastes including COSHH, spill response, contaminated soil, asbestos and Japanese Knotweed.
- Highly visible onsite- clearly identifies to site team and waste contractors that the waste is hazardous.
- Suitable for restricted access areas.
- Certified for lifting.
- Reduced transport emissions and cost when removed offsite- takes up less space than drums and traditional containers. Therefore, reducing the carbon emissions and cost of transporting the waste.
