Balloon Lighting



Description of the good practice

A type of lighting that is economical but gives great visibility for teams at night without glare or blinding when working near plant.

What are the benefits?

Provides lighting in more than one direction, easy to store, set up and can be plugged in. A balloon light is glare free, shadow reduced and spreads light in a 360° circle without any dark spots.

Are there any drawbacks?

More expensive than smith lights or tower lights. At time of writing - Balloon Lights @ £50.99 per week.
